The COVID-19 epidemic has had a profound impact on the activities of the Pacific Open Heart Association. Visits to surgical and feeder hospitals have been discontinued, as have visits to pre-admission clinics at the Royal Columbian Hospital.

POHA is making adjustments to these unprecedented circumstances.

A video visit!

Adrienne White has collaborated with Royal Columbian Hospital and Velvet Pumpkin Productions to create a pre- and post-surgery “video visit.” Open-heart patients at the surgical hospitals are able to view the 27-minute presentation. Adrienne covers three subjects in the video: frequently-asked questions; the healing process; tips for going home.

Adrienne had quadruple bypass surgery in 2018 and authored the lead article in the July 2019 newsletter.

These “virtual visits” will maintain the Pacific Open Heart Association’s presence in the lower mainland.
